

The Cape May Custom models offers the finest carriage door styles in our most customizeable, maintenance free construction.

Cape May models are crafted using only PVC (with polystyrene insulation), with no risk of rot or rust. Its unique construction combines the advantages of weatherproof, bright

white PVC with traditional carpentry.

Cape May series doors are built on a 1" thick PVC frame with advanced polystyrene insulation. Frames are backed with ½" thick smooth white PVC sheet. The framing is overlayed with ½" thick flat or v-grooved PVC panels, overlayed with ½" thick stiles and rails.

Raised panel designs are also available. Cape May custom models are 2-1/4" thick and available up to 10' wide.


Cape Hatteras doors offer an exterior surface of bright white PVC on

industry leading steel base sections. The flush white steel base features a polyurethane core, providing a 2-3/4" thick well insulated R-18 door.


1/2" PVC Inlay

Steel sections are faced with ½" PVC panels and ½" stile and rail PVC overlays. Doors are available in section heights of 18", 21" or 24" and up to 20' wide. 36" top glass sections are also available, allowing for industry customized glass openings.





Cape Cod Custom models offer an attractive price for a maintenance free carriage door look.

These models feature the same edge detail customers love about traditional wood

doors without the upkeep. Cape Cod doors are 100% bright white PVC.

They are built on a 1-1/4" thick PVC sheet that can be flat or v-grooved. Craftsmen apply 1/2" thick overlays over the flat or v-grooved sheet base.

Raised panel designs are also available. All Cape Cod models have a flat PVC interior side. Cape Cod models are 1-3/4" thick.

Cape Elizabeth Custom models combine Everite's traditional hand crafted overlays with smooth, thick steel panels to create an economical carriage door look.



face! The doors begin with 1-3/8" thick, 20 gage smooth steel base sections that craftsmen face with 1/2" thick composite overlays.


Colors are Polar White or Brown; overlays are color matched, interior face is flush wood grained face that can be upgraded to smooth.

Base models are 1-7/8" thick and are available up to 18' wide. Models can be upgraded to 2-1/4" thick R-18 insulation.



Powder Coating

Everite's state-of-the-art powder coating service offers a high-end finish for your garage door track and hardware accessories. Powder coating protects your garage door track and offers a beautiful colored finish to amplify the statement made by your new custom Everite doors.

Why Powder Coat?

Powder coating is an innovative finishing process that applies a fine, dry powder to the metal surface of the door's track, hardware or other components. The powder is heated and cured inside an industrial oven until powdery finish becomes smooth and resilient. Powder coating not only advances the aesthetic of your garage but also protects its hardware from rust and weathering. Properly functioning hardware is important to the function and longevity of your garage door.

Note: Everite individually wraps each item for shipment to ensure a flawless finish at delivery.

Factory powder coating is available with any Everite track, face hardware, struts, aluminum retainers or bracing, decorative hardware, or other manufacturer's add-ons. The finish can also be applied to customer supplied components for other projects. Our team is experienced in powder coating lighting fixtures, railings, outdoor furniture, car accessories, and much more. Maintaining Your Powder Coating

Much like your doors, a regular cleaning helps maintain the beauty of the powder coated finish. Use a mild soap with soft brush or cloth to spot clean, or pressure wash using a low-pressure setting and filtered water. Light cleaning should be done at minimum 1-2 times per year. Clean more frequently if your product is regularly exposed to debris or harsh weather conditions.


Finishing

Everite's best in class factory finish capabilities allows for better protection of your new Cape Series Door. Everite recommends a white factory finish to extend the fresh clean look for many years. The applied paint will not peel or fade for the door's lifetime. Some factory applied, darker solid and stain colors are possible with strict directional limitations. Consult your representative for details.

Warranty Details

Cape Series models do not need to be painted and can be left white. Cape Series Models carry a 3 year limited warranty. If doors are field painted, a Vinyl Safe paint with a color whose LRV ("Light Reflective Value") is greater than 55 MUST be used to maintain the factory warranty.

Everite Cape Series models are primarily made from bright white Versatex PVC. Versatex is a cellular PVC material leading the way in innovation of its category. This material does not require painting or sealing and will not swell with moisture or rot. Its dense cell structure produces smoother profiles, improved paint acceptance, less yellowing under sunlight, and fewer dents and scuffs than competing PVC brands.

Superior Detail

Every Everite Door is handmade to order. We utilize the same traditional building process, wood production equipment, and carpentry expertise to the create edge detail and profiles equivalent to those featured in our custom wood doors.

True Divided Lites Standard

Simulated divided lites have become the industry norm.
At Everite, true divided lites remain the standard, even when glass is insulated.

Tried & True Manufacturing Techniques

Everite uses the same joining and edging techniques used in traditional wood door construction. Everite doors are stick built with square corners, featuring quarter round edge profiles around glass and panels. Customized edge profiles, including bead, ogee, beveled, square, and others are also available. Our craftsmen masterfully combine classic building methods with cutting edge weather resistant materials to offer a truly timeless product.
